

Getting the sizes right..


It's important to get the sizes right!
In order to make sure that everything
fits these measurements are essential.


Although some measurements are
particular to Women, the following list
provides a complete set of dimensions
appropriate to both sexes.

The waist is in line with the belly button
(not necessarily where people wear their
trousers hitched up or down).

When measuring from the nape of the
neck, the nape is considered to be the
point at the first vertebrae of your neck
(the collar line).

1. Circumference of the head
2. Measure around the neck
3. Measure the chest all the way around
4. Measure the waist (level with belly button)
5. Measure the hips (the widest point)
6. Measure from the waist to the knee
7. Measure from waist to floor without shoes





8. Measure the shoulders across the back
9. Measure the back from the nape of the neck to the waist
10. Measure across the chest arm seam to arm seam
11. Measure the inside arm from armpit to wrist
12. Measure the circumference of the wrist
13. Measure the circumference of the thigh
14. Measure the inside leg or the leg of a pair of trousers that fit
15. Measure the height
16. Note down Shoe size
